#### **RULES**

- 1. All competitions are Open except those marked Local the latter are reserved for those who were or are native (born & bred) residents of Skye and Lochalsh and also those who have been resident for the six months prior to these Games. Pipers may enter Local or Open Piping Competitions, but not both, except that local pipers may enter for the under 18 Open Competitions.
- Competitors in Piping, Dancing and Open Heavy events must appear in Highland Garb. Those in other Athletic events should wear athletic costume.
- 3. The various Competitions will take place in the order fixed by the committee.
- 4. In track and field events there must be at least 3 competitors in each event failing which there will be no competition.
- 5. Three throws to be allowed with stone and hammer and three tosses for caber.
- 6. The hammer to be thrown without a turn and 7'6" run allowed with a Stone.
- 7. In any dispute that may arise and in all questions connected with the Games during the day, the decision of the Committee, or Judges appointed by them, shall be final.
- 8. The Committee reserve the right to exclude any competitor without reason being given and also to alter the programme if necessary.
- 9. All competitors must submit their names to the Judge for the event when each event is announced on the Public Address system, failing which entry may not be accepted. However, Dancing and Open Piping Competitions must be entered prior to the Games.
